GENERAL INFORMATION

DRESS CODE

On the Golf Course and Practice Facilities.

Conventional golf attire is required on the golf course and when using the practice facilities.

- Denim wear is unacceptable, as are track suits, tee shirts and tops designed for other sports.
- Shirts / tops should be tucked in with the exception of those specifically designed otherwise.)
- Approved golfing footwear with hard or soft spikes must be worn
- Shorts and skirts must be tailored or designed for golf, and not designed for other sports.
- Socks, when worn with shorts/skirts, must be either white or match your outfit or shoe colour.

In the Clubhouse.

- Please ensure all clothing is clean and dry
- Hats or caps should not be worn in the clubhouse
- Cleated golfing footwear should not be worn in the bar/lounge and the dining areas. Clean soft spikes are permitted during the summer months. No flip flops or other beach wear are allowed.

Functions and Club Events

All Club functions and events require appropriate standards of attire and the dress code for each event will be included when promoting the function or event.

GOLF BUGGIES

Golf Buggies must be operated with the utmost courtesy, care and consideration for the safety and convenience of all persons on or off the golf course. The signs and instructions employed on the golf course to warn Golf Buggy users of potential danger areas or areas forbidden to Golf Buggies because of concerns about danger or the potential to cause unacceptable wear and tear to the course, must be adhered to at all times. Golf Buggies must not be driven on the tee areas, driven, bunkers and the greens or within close proximity to the greens.

TROLLEYS

All users of trolleys should ensure at all times trolleys are not parked on the tee areas or taken between the bunkers and the greens.

MOBILE PHONE POLICY

Please consider others when using your mobile phone. In the Clubhouse, voice calls should only be made outside of the bar/lounge and dining room areas.

SMOKING POLICY

Smoking or vaping is not permitted within the Clubhouse. Out of respect for all, please take care not to cause offence when smoking outside the Clubhouse.

Club staff are authorised to approach those not adhering to the regulations. Failure to comply with these regulations may result in you being asked to leave the course, practice facilities or the Clubhouse.
