Membership - Terms & Conditions

1. Introduction

- 1.1 These terms and conditions form part of your membership with Shifnal Golf Club (1964) Ltd ('the Golf Club'). Your membership of the Golf Club is based on the acceptance of these terms and conditions and the Club Rules (as referred to in paragraph 1.3).
- 1.2 Please make sure that you read them carefully and understand them. If you have any questions, please ask a member of our admin staff.
- 1.3 You, and all visitors to the Golf Club, must adhere at all times to the Club Rules which are displayed on the Club website, the notice board within the Clubhouse or a copy is available from the Admin Office.

2. Period of Membership

2.1 Membership is for a fixed period from your date of joining to 31 March ('the Membership Year'). If you wish to accept membership you are committing yourself to the full Membership Year.

3. Membership Fees

- 3.1 The cost of your membership will depend on the type of membership you have chosen.
- 3.2 We will set out all amounts that you need to pay for your membership on your invoice.
- 3.3 If you are not sure about the membership fees you are paying, please speak to a member of our admin staff.

4. Payment Options

- 4.1 The types of payment option we offer are as follows:
- 4.1.1 Pay in Full. With this payment option you must make payment in full. You cannot use the facilities of the Golf Club until payment has been received. No further payment is due until the following year's renewal date of 1 April. Payment can be made by cheque payable to 'Shifnal Golf Club', bank transfer to sort code 20-85-46 and account number 13716147, cash, debit card, or credit card.
- 4.1.2 <u>Deferred Payment Scheme ('DPS')</u>. With this payment option you agree to pay your membership fee by monthly instalments for the Membership Year. An admin fee will be added to your invoice and monthly instalment amounts will be calculated by the admin staff. You are responsible for setting up a monthly Bank Standing Order on the 1st of each month from your bank account into the Golf Club's bank account commencing on the 1st day of the month after membership commences, with the final payment due on 1 March. The sort code of the Golf Club's bank account is 20-85-46 and the account number is 13716147. *If you wish to pay via this method, please let our admin staff know of your intentions so that they can record your preferred method of payment.*

5. Suspending your Membership

- 5.1 In accordance with the Club Rules referred to in paragraph 1.3 above, you may apply in writing to the Board of Directors for your membership to be voluntarily suspended from the start of the Membership Year only. No applications will be accepted during the Membership Year. Members should be aware that any suspension of their membership will break their continuity of membership.
- 5.2 The Board shall have absolute discretion on whether such application should be accepted.
- 5.3 If the Board shall approve the application for voluntary suspension, it shall be subject to the following:
- 5.3.1 The suspension shall be for the full Membership Year.
- 5.3.2 If the member's circumstances change, the member can apply to the Board for reinstatement during the period of suspension providing a vacancy in the Club exists.
- 5.3.3 A member may apply to the Board for an extension of the suspension at the end of the Membership Year but such request must be made in writing to the Admin Office not less than 30 days prior to the commencement of the next Membership Year.
- 5.4 A suspended member will be entitled to:
- 5.4.1 Use the Clubhouse facilities but this shall not include any of the golf practice facilities at the Club.
- 5.4.2 Play golf on 2 occasions free of charge during a Membership Year, and bring up to 3 guests at the current members' guest green fee.
- 5.4.3 Play golf on 4 more occasions with up to 3 guests, with all 4 paying the members' guest green fee rate.
- 5.4.4 Golf as provided in 5.4.2 or 5.4.3 is only available for midweek golf, Monday-Friday. The golf is required to be booked by the suspended member, through the Pro Shop. The suspended member must provide the card provided by the Admin Office, which will be punched in the Pro Shop to show the rounds that have been used.
- 5.5 The member shall lose all rights and privileges of their membership for the period of suspension (with the exception of those outlined in 5.4)
- 5.6 The member shall be required to pay the Suspended Member's subscription (as decided by the Board) during the period of suspension.
- 5.7 The Board may impose such other conditions as they consider appropriate.
- 5.8 The Board shall have the right to vary or amend the terms of such suspension at their absolute discretion.

6. Resigning your Membership

- 6.1 To resign your membership you must send your notice in writing prior to 1 April. Your resignation letter may be sent to the Admin Office by post, or by email to secretary@shifnalgolf.com
- On receipt of your resignation, our admin staff will arrange for any monies owed to you to be paid within 30 days of the start of the new Membership Year.
- 6.3 We will issue any refunds due to you by bank transfer or by cheque to the address we have on record for you unless otherwise advised in writing.
- 6.4 If a member shall resign their membership for whatever reason during the Membership Year they shall not be entitled to any refund of the membership fee paid for the remainder of the Membership Year.

If a member shall resign their membership for whatever reason during the Membership Year and has elected to pay their membership fee under DPS they shall continue to be liable to pay the balance of their membership fee for the remainder of the Membership Year until the membership fee has been paid in full. If the member shall default in making any payment under DPS on the due date the balance then owing for the Membership Year shall be immediately payable in full and interest will be charged at the rate of 4% above the base lending rate from time to time. Such interest shall accrue on a daily basis from the due date until actual payment of the overdue amount, whether before or after judgment.

7. Force Majeure

Force Majeure Events means circumstances not within the Golf Club's reasonable control including without limitation, acts of god, flooding, drought, fire, explosion or accident, epidemic or pandemic, other natural disasters or any law or any action taken by a government or public authority.

If during the Membership Year the Golf Club shall be closed for any Force Majeure Events the Golf Club shall not be liable to a member for the closure of the Golf Club nor shall a member be entitled to terminate their membership during the current Membership Year or seek any refund of the membership fees paid or claim any other compensation.

8. General

Your membership of the Golf Club shall be a deemed acceptance of the terms and conditions as set out above.
